RE: Construction of sidewalk and street improvements on Ben Nevis Boulevard from Conning Street to 200' east of Lindsay Street, in the unincorporated community of Glen Avon.

March 10, 2011

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BACKGROUND:

The Transportation Improvement Program provides for the construction of sidewalk and related street improvements along Ben Nevis Boulevard from Conning Street to 200 feet east of Lindsay Street, which is a known pedestrian route for children attending Mission Bell Elementary School, located on Conning Street south of Ben Nevis Boulevard.

The adjustment of conflicting utilities owned by the Jurupa Community Service District (JCSD) is included in the bid package as two alternate bid schedules. If JCSD approves the award of the alternate bid schedules, as bid by the apparent low bidder, the costs for the work will be funded by JCSD.

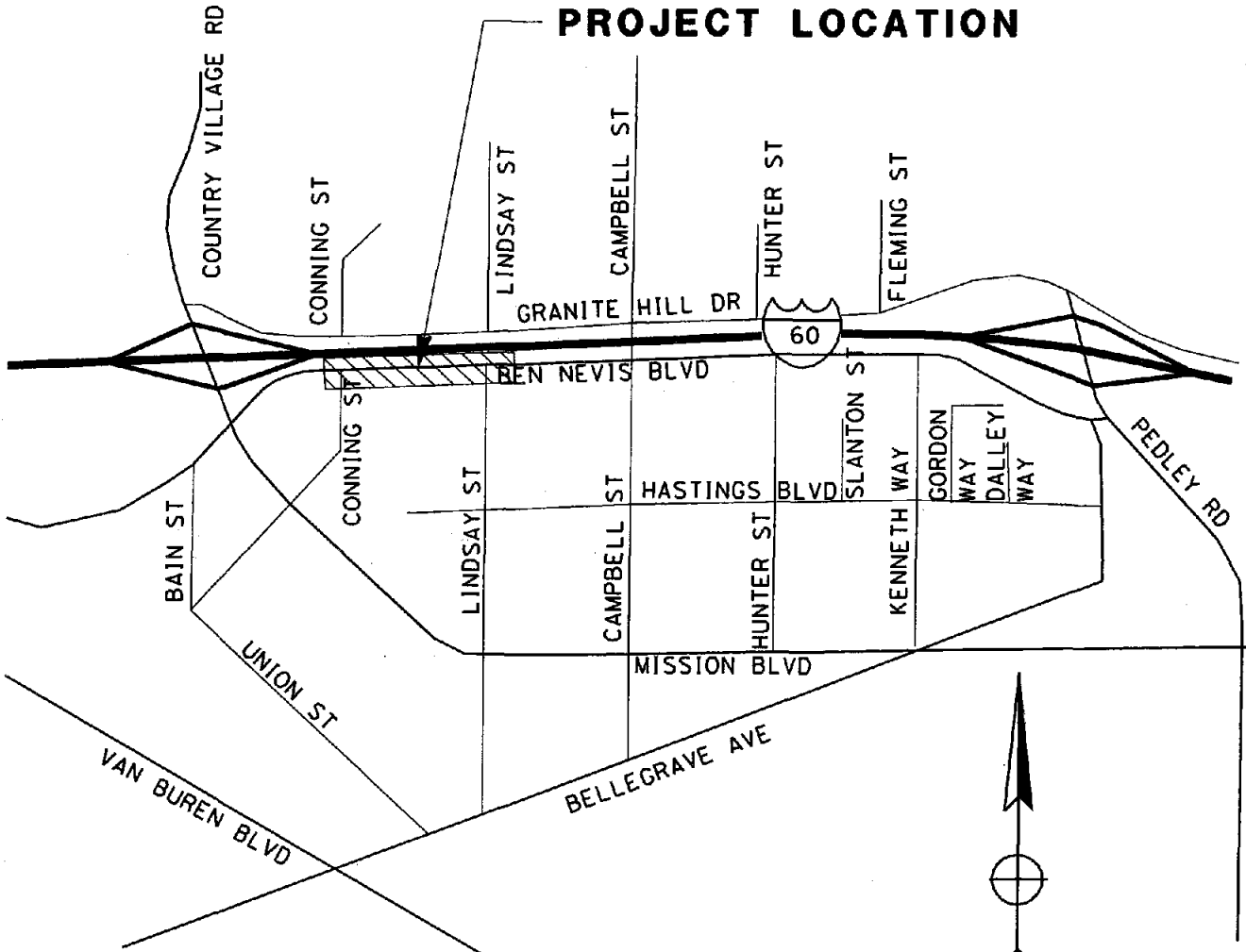
The proposed work is to be funded by SB 821 Local Transportation funds, as well as by Redevelopment Agency funds through a cooperative agreement that will be submitted to the Board of Supervisors for execution prior to, or concurrent with, the award of the construction contract. The SB 821 funds were secured through a grant for which the Transportation Department successfully competed.

The submitted plans and specifications have been approved as to form by County Counsel.
