SUBJECT: Professional Services Agreement-Yvonne J. Kochanowski, SteelEdge Business Consulting


RECOMMENDED MOTION: That The Board of Supervisors:

BACKGROUND: The Office on Aging was awarded a grant from the California Department of Health Services, to study components of Long Term Care systems as one of the demonstration projects funded in the State of California. Funds provided under this grant will purchase consultant services related to the study of the integration of home and community based service systems with seniors and adults with disabilities. Term of this contract to cover services from January 1, 2003 to June 30, 2003 for \$19,300.



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BACKGROUND: (continud)

Previous agenda reference 3.2 (February 5, 2002) covers personal service contract for Yvonne J. Kochanowski in the amount of \$42,800 to perform a review of the progress of the project to date, interview key informants and community leaders, review all Medi-Cal and Medicare data, review models conceptualized or implemented in California and other states, formulate and finalize a case management model, develop and finalize organization and governance, prepare a comprehensive report on the conceptual plan, recommend phases for implementation, and review and prepare a report on financial feasibility and risk.

Previous agenda reference 3.10 (May 14, 2002) covers personal service contract for Yvonne J. Kochanowski in the amount of \$6,000 to write the fourth year State of California Department of Health Services, Office of Long Term Care Integration Grant Application.

Retaining Dr. Kochanowski as the consultant for the Long Term Care project is the result of a competitive bidding process and will assure the successful completion of the multiple tasks in this project.
