
**SUBJECT:** Ratify the First Amendment to the Agreement No. DPH02K.073 with the Riverside County Superintendent of Schools and the EMS Agency Injury Prevention Program

**RECOMMENDED MOTION:** That the Board of Supervisors: 1) Ratify the First Amendment to the Agreement between the Riverside County Superintendent of Schools and the Riverside Community Health Agency, Emergency Medical Services (EMS) Agency in the amount of \$50,000 for the performance period of July 1, 2002 to and including June 30, 2003; 2) Authorize the Chairman of the Board to sign four (4) original Amendments; and 3) Direct the Clerk of the Board to retain one original amendment and return three (3) originals to the Community Health Agency Contracts Administration.

**BACKGROUND:** On December 11, 2001, Item 3.4, the Board of Supervisors approved the agreement with the subcontractor, Riverside County Superintendent of Schools, to assist in the development and maintenance of the Injury Prevention Network Program. The Riverside County Superintendent of Schools Community Partnership Program will continue to assist the Riverside County Emergency Medical Services (EMS) Agency with the implementation of the Prop 10 Riverside County Children's Injury Network Program being funded by the Riverside County Children and Family Commission.


