SUBJECT: Approval of Standard Agreement No. 02-008-550-0 with State Water Resources Control Board for Oversight of Underground Storage Tank Cleanup

RECOMMENDED MOTION:

1) Move that the Board approve the standard Agreement with the State Water Resources Control Board for FY 2002/2003 for the contract total of \$331,000. 2) Adopt Resolution No. 2003-74 authorizing the Chairman to execute four (4) copies of the Agreement on behalf of the County. 3) The Clerk of the Board to return four (4) copies of the signed Agreements to the Community Health Agency, Environmental Health Department for further processing.

BACKGROUND: The annual State contract is the standard agreement with the State Water Resources Control Board for the County to continue to identify and oversee the investigation and clean up of releases from underground storage tanks. Program costs are fully offset by funding from the State Water Resources Control Board.

RESOLUTION NO. 2003-74

AUTHORIZING CONTRACT WITH STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD FOR OVERSIGHT BY COUNTY FOR UNDERGROUND STORAGE TANK CLEANUP

WHEREAS, the State of California's Agency for Clean Water Programs, designates the State Water Resources Control Board to distribute funds for site cleanup of leaking Underground Storage Tanks pursuant to Section 25297.1 of the California Health and Safety Code and Title 23, Section 2621, Division 3, Chapters 16 and 18 of the California Code of Regulations; and

WHEREAS, since 1989 the County of Riverside has maintained through the Department of Environmental Health the Local Oversight Program under the Hazardous Materials Management Division; and

WHEREAS, the County has the Local Oversight Program with the means to identify and oversee the investigation and remediation of the Underground Storage Tank petroleum release within its jurisdiction to protect the County groundwater; now, therefore

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors, County of Riverside, State of California, in regular session assembled on February 4, 2003, that the Chairman of this Board is authorized and directed to execute on behalf of said County of Riverside Contract No. 02-008-550-0, dated July 1, 2002, between the County of Riverside and the California State Water Resources Control Board providing for investigation and cleanup from underground storage tank releases.
