SUBJECT: Ordinance 452.214 to Correct and Update Existing Ordinance 452 Relating to Prima Facie Speed Limits Throughout Riverside County


RECOMMENDED MOTION:

That the Board introduce attached Ordinance 452.214, which amends Ordinance No. 452 relating to prima facie speed limits to establish current speed zones, and repeals existing Ordinances 452.27 through 452.213, inclusive, throughout Riverside County.

BACKGROUND:

It was determined by the Transportation Department that, over the years, due to annexations and incorporations by cities, acquisitions and relinquishments of roads by Caltrans, or street name changes, a review of all existing amending ordinances for Ordinance 452 was necessary. During this review, and in discussions with County Counsel, it was also determined that, because the existing numbering system had become so extensive as to be cumbersome, a comprehensive re-numbering of existing Ordinance No. 452 becomes necessary.

Transportation Department staff has conducted Engineering and Traffic Survey (E&TS) for roads throughout Riverside County, as required by the California Vehicle Code. The speed zones listed in Ordinance 452.214 are speed zones that have previously been approved by the Board in Ordinances 452.27 through 452.213. Ordinance No. 452.30, approved by the Board on February 3, 1964, repeals Ordinances 452.1 through 452.26, inclusive.






BACKGROUND: (continued)

This amending ordinance is to correct and update Ordinance 452, and also to put into effect a new numbering system for this ordinance. This amending ordinance is comprised only of **existing, previously-approved** speed zones. *No new speed zones or changes of existing speed limits are included in this amendment.* All speed zones are based upon the results of the E&TS for these roads and are radar-enforceable speed limits.

It is recommended that the Board adopt this amendment at the next regularly scheduled meeting.

The Office of the Clerk of the Board has reviewed this ordinance amendment, which has been reviewed and approved by County Counsel.

Transportation Department staff will provide a copy of the new ordinance to the Riverside, San Geronio, Temecula, Indio, and Blythe Area offices of the California Highway Patrol upon approval by the Board of Supervisors.
