(Jim Bennett) - First Supervisorial District - Temescal / El Cerrito Community Zoning District - 31.53 Acres - M-R-A zoning - Located in Temescal Canyon in the unincorporated area of the County of Riverside, approximately 6 miles southerly of the City of Corona - REQUEST: To extend duration of their existing permit for surface mining of fill material, sand and gravel for redi-mix concrete, asphalt concrete, and other construction and specialty end-uses.
