SUBJECT: Ratify the FY 2002/03 First Amendment to Renewal Agreement with Mizell Senior Center of Palm Springs.


RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors:

- 1) Ratify the attached First Amendment to the Renewal Agreement with Mizell Senior Center of Palm Springs.
- 2) Authorize Chairman of the Board to sign the agreement.
- 3) Direct the Clerk of the Board to retain one (1) original copy and return two (2) copies to the Office on Aging for further processing.

BACKGROUND: The agreement with Mizell Senior Center of Palm Springs, covering the period July 1, 2002 through June 30, 2003, in the amount of \$159,267 (Previous Agenda Item 3.16 on November 26, 2002) has been awarded increased funding of \$26,451 increasing the agreement maximum to \$185,718. This additional funding will enhance the meal programs to the seniors of Palm Springs. These Riverside County seniors are eligible to participate in either the Congregate Meals Program or, if homebound, the Home Delivered Meals Program. Both programs consist of the procurement, preparation, and serving/delivery of meals, as well as nutritional education and counseling.
