SUBJECT: Agreement with State DHS for Contracted County Medi-Cal Administrative Activities (MAA) Allowable for FFP

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors: 1) Approve the Agreement for fiscal years 2002-03 and 2003-04 (July 01, 2002 through June 30, 2004) with the California State Department of Health Services as it pertains to Medi-Cal Administrative Activities (MAA) allowable for Federal Financial Participation (FFP); 2) That the Chairman of the Board of Supervisors sign the Agreement on behalf of the County of Riverside; 3) Direct the Community Health Agency Director to enter into MOU's with various County departments that will claim FFP under this Agreement; 4) Authorize receipt of funds into a trust fund to be held for distribution; and 5) Direct the Director of CHA to collect a proportional amount of monies from participating departments for costs incurred in the coordination of this Agreement.

BACKGROUND: On July 21, 1992, the Board authorized the Director of the Health Services Agency to coordinate SB-910 implementation activities for the County, of which Medi-Cal Administrative Activities is a part. In order to continue participation in the Medi-Cal Administrative Activities, a new Agreement with the State Department of Health Services (SDHS) must be signed. (Continued)



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BACKGROUND: (CONT'D)

This Agreement continues to allow the County to receive FFP for Medi-Cal Administrative Activities, via the State's Administrative Plan for eligible clients. The Community Health Agency is acting as the single County Agency through which claims will be made under this Agreement. The Agency is anticipating a net of \$400,000 from this contract. No budget adjustment is required as it is already in the Agency budget. The remaining \$5,600,000 is distributed to various school districts participating in the program.
