**SUBJECT: BOARD DISCUSSION OF COUNTY LOBBYIST - SACRAMENTO**

**RECOMMENDED MOTION:** That the Board of Supervisors consider the need for hiring a second lobbying firm in Sacramento, and if determined to be necessary, the process to be followed in order to secure said firm.

**BACKGROUND:**

Three members of our Board have been contacted by certain members of our State Legislators – Inland Empire Caucus, relative to their desire that our Board consider the addition of a second lobbying firm in Sacramento. While our current lobbyist, John Quimby and Pam Milligan, have provided great service and value to our county, it is the belief of our State legislative delegation, that added value might be achieved through the addition of a second firm. This Board needs to determine whether the additional cost should be expended at this time in order to contract with a second firm, and whether added value could be achieved.
