SUBJECT: Consulting Services Agreement: URS Corporation
NPDES Permit Renewal / Report of Waste Discharge
Santa Margarita River Watershed

RECOMMENDED MOTION:

- 1) Approve the Consulting Services Agreement between the District and URS Corporation;
- 2) Authorize the Chairman to execute the agreement documents on behalf of the District; and
- 3) Direct the Purchasing Department to issue a purchase order on behalf of the District.

JUSTIFICATION:

The agreement is necessary to provide the District and its co-permittees (County of Riverside, City of Murrieta and City of Temecula) with necessary technical and regulatory assistance in conjunction with the pending renewal of the area-wide NPDES Municipal Stormwater Permit for the Santa Margarita Watershed.

County Counsel has approved the consulting services agreement as to legal form.

FINANCIAL:

Under the contract, URS will provide services through June 30, 2004 for a "not to exceed" price of \$180,000. Sufficient funds have been included in the District's NPDES Santa Margarita Watershed Benefit Assessment fund for FY 2002-03 and will be included in proposed FY 2003-04 budget.
