**RECOMMENDED MOTION:** That the Board of Supervisors: 1) Ratify the Second Amendment to the Agreement between Catholic Charities and the Riverside County Community Health Agency (CHA), Department of Public Health in the amount of \$8,656 from the Regional Access Project and an increase in funding of \$16,688 from the Riverside County Children and Families Commission (RCCFC), for a total of \$25,344; 3) Authorize the Chairman of the Board to sign four (4) original copies of the Amendment; 4) Direct the Clerk of the Board to file one (1) copy, and return three (3) copies of the Amendment to the Community Health Agency Contracts Administrator for further processing.

**SUBJECT:** Ratify the Second Amendment to the Agreement No. DPH02K.081 between Catholic Charities and Riverside County Community Health Agency, Department of Public Health

**BACKGROUND:** Riverside County Department of Public Health Disease Control Branch, in collaboration with Catholic Charities, Jurupa Community Partnership, and Valley Health System developed the Healthy Children Connection (HCC) Program with the goal of promoting early entry into prenatal care and timely immunizations of children. Catholic Charities offers services to clients in Supervisorial District 4, Jurupa Community Partnership in District 2, and Valley Health System in District 3, respectively. A second grant, funded by RCCFC, provides services in Districts 1 and 5, and was approved by the Board on October 8, 2002, item 3.4. The contract was renegotiated for FY 02/03 due to program expansion and an additional amount of \$16,688 was awarded by RCCFC for an increase from \$95,712 to \$112,400.

The subcontractors recruit, train, and utilize community volunteers as peer counselors to provide door-to-door outreach to families regarding early prenatal care and timely childhood immunizations. The project involves a coordinated media outreach effort, close coordination with the immunization project, and the development of a Referral Triage Guide to ensure clients are referred to the most appropriate service providers.

The Riverside County Community Health Agency, Department of Public Health is now collaborating with Palo Verde Unified School District and Catholic Charities to expand the Healthy Children Connection Program to the Palo Verde Valley. This expansion is being funded by the Regional Access Project in the amount of \$8,656.

Although the Riverside County Department of Public Health is the lead Agency, collaborative partners are needed to ensure effective implementation of the program at a local level.

This amendment has been approved as to form by County Counsel.
