
SUBJECT: 2002 Labor Market Study

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Riverside County Board of Supervisors approve and authorize the Chairman to execute Standard Agreement No. M278305 Amendment #1 between the Employment Development Department (EDD) and the County of Riverside.

BACKGROUND: Riverside County was awarded \$58,028 by EDD to conduct a labor market study of 25 occupations for Program Year 2001/02 under the California Cooperative Occupational Information System (CCOIS). The Economic Development Agency (EDA) is working with the EDD Labor Market Information Division in the collection, analysis and dissemination of local occupational outlook and training resource information. The information is used primarily by local employment and training agencies in program planning, program marketing, career counseling, job placement, curriculum design and economic development. The results derived from this study will also be utilized to provide information to enhance Workforce Investment Act (WIA) Rapid Response activities throughout Riverside County.

The Riverside County Board of Supervisors approved this agreement on January 29, 2002. This amendment being submitted for approval is to extend the term of the agreement by two (2) months to allow EDA to complete the terms of the contract. The amended term will be January 1, 2002, through March 31 2003. (No monetary change). All other terms and conditions shall remain the same.


