RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors approve and:

- 1) Authorize the Chairman of the Board to sign the attached Agreement #03B-5232 between Department of Community Services and Development (CSD) and the Department of Public Social Services-Department of Community Action (DPSS-DCA) for the Low-Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP) to provide utility assistance, weatherization services and energy-efficient appliances to qualified residents of Riverside County, for the period January 1, 2003 through December 31, 2003, not to exceed \$111,946; and
- 2) Authorize the Director of the Department of Public Social Services (DPSS) to sign assurances, exhibits, and reports made under the Agreement.

**BACKGROUND:**

In 2002, the Board approved LIHEAP agreements and amendments with CSD to accept program year 2002 funding to: 1) assist low-income consumers with high energy bills, 2) repair or replace furnaces and other heating devices that contribute to high energy consumption, and 3) weatherize homes. This Agreement #03B-5232 establishes program year 2003 and would continue to provide the same services.

Congress has not yet decided the final LIHEAP allocation, therefore, this Agreement supplies the initial allocation which is based on 2 months of the 2001 LIHEAP allocation. This Agreement will be amended once the Congressional appropriation is approved, and the State is advised of its final grant award.

Therefore, the Director of DPSS-DCA requests the Board to approve Agreement #03B-5232 for LIHEAP weatherization covering the period January 1, 2003 through December 31, 2003, not to exceed \$111,946.

**FINANCIAL IMPACT:** No County General Funds will be required. Sufficient funds have been appropriated in the DPSS-DCA budget for this purpose.
