RECOMMENDED MOTION:

Approve the agreement and authorize the Chairman to sign the agreement on behalf of the District.

JUSTIFICATION:

The Implementation Agreement is a requirement of the NPDES Municipal Stormwater Discharge Permit (NPDES Permit) issued by the Colorado River Basin Regional Water Quality Control Board (Board Order 01-077). The agreement establishes the responsibilities of each party with respect to the NPDES Permit for the Whitewater River permit area.

FINANCIAL:

Costs incurred by the District will be funded by the existing Whitewater Watershed Benefit Assessment Area for the NPDES Program.
