SUBJECT: State-County Property Tax Administration Program Renewal

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board approve and authorize the Chariman to execute the attached agreement with the State renewing the County Property Tax Administration Program grant.

BACKGROUND: On November 21, 1995, the County elected to participate in the State-County Property Tax Administration Loan Program which provided for a loan for the purpose of enhancing its property tax administration. For the 2002/03 fiscal year, this program was changed to a grant. Whereas the former loan program required the Assessor to establish goals and meet the goals in order for the loan to be considered repaid, the new grant program requires the Assessor to be evaluated on a "whole office approach," which identifies property tax roll value added by the Assessor and how that translates to added revenue for schools.

The application for the FY 2002-2003 grant is in the amount of \$2,358,068, which equals the loan amounts applied for by the Assessor since FY 1995-96.
