RECOMMENDED MOTION: Move that the Board of Supervisors:

- (1) assess the reasonable costs of abatement of a public nuisance (2 substandard structures and excessive outside storage of materials) in the above-referenced matter to be eleven thousand, seven hundred, fifty-eight dollars and fifty-eight cents (US \$11,758.58);
- (2) assess the costs of abatement against the above-described subject property;
- (3) authorize the recordation of a notice of abatement lien; and
- (4) authorize the abatement costs to be added to the tax roll as a special assessment.


BACKGROUND: Government Code § 25845, Riverside County Ordinance Nos. 348 (RCC Title 17), 457 (RCC Title 15) 725(h-1) (RCC Title 1) authorize the recovery of abatement costs in public nuisance cases, the recordation of a notice of abatement lien and inclusion of abatement costs on the tax roll as a special assessment upon approval of the Board of Supervisors.

The Board of Supervisors issued an Order to Abate in this case on February 5, 2002. After expiration of the ninety-day stay of execution of the Board's order, two (2) substandard structures and excessive outside storage of materials located on the subject property were abated under direction of the Riverside County Department of Building and Safety pursuant to a seizure warrant.

The property has a delinquent tax status as of 2001.

All notices regarding the Statement of Expense hearing have been given to Lawrence A. Moore and Ginnie L. Moore, the property owners, as required by law (see attached exhibits).


