
SUBJECT: Recommendation for Distribution of Excess Proceeds for Tax Sale No. 159, Item 1110.  
Last assessed to: Arthur Windsor.

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors:

- 1) Approve the claim from Leasecomm Corporation for payment of excess proceeds resulting from the Tax Collector's public auction sale associated with parcel 580350028-7;
- 2) Approve the claim from Julie Shular, agent for Arthur Windsor, last assessee for payment of excess proceeds resulting from the Tax Collector's public auction sale associated with parcel 580350028-7;
- 3) Authorize and direct the Auditor-Controller to issue warrants to Leasecomm Corporation c/o Laurence A. Rose, attorney in the amount of \$1,532.40 and Julie Shular, agent for Arthur Windsor in the amount of \$10,078.95 no sooner then ninety days from the date of this order, unless pursuant to the California Revenue and Taxation Code Section 4675, an appeal has been filed in Superior Court.

**BACKGROUND:** In accordance with Section 3691 et seq. of the California Revenue and Taxation Code, and with prior approval of the Board of Supervisors, the Tax Collector conducted the March 12, 2001 public auction sale. The deed conveying title to the purchasers at the auction was recorded May 10, 2001. Further, as required by Section 4676 of the California Revenue and Taxation Code, notice of the right to claim excess proceeds was given on May 31, 2001, to parties of interest as defined in Section 4675 of said code. Parties of interest have been determined by an examination of lot book reports as well as Assessor's and Recorder's records, and various research methods were used to obtain current mailing addresses for these parties of interest.


