SUBJECT: Approval of the Interagency Agreement with the City of La Quinta for Reimbursement of Operating Expenses of the Coachella Valley Violent Crime Gang Task Force

RECOMMENDED MOTION: Approve the attached Interagency Agreement with the City of La Quinta for reimbursement of current year operating costs for the Coachella Valley Violent Crime Gang Task Force, and authorize the Chairman to execute the agreement.

BACKGROUND: Under M.O. 3.43, dated August 13, 2002, the Board approved acceptance of the FY 2002-03 Juvenile Accountability Incentive Block Grant (JAIBG), which provided \$658,245 in Federal funds to the County. The County, in consortium with 14 cities (Banning, Blythe, Cathedral City, Coachella, Corona, Desert Hot Springs, Hemet, Indio, La Quinta, Moreno Valley, Palm Desert, Palm Springs, Perris, Riverside and Temecula), created a Riverside County Regional Enforcement Plan to implement programs for the current fiscal year. One element of the plan provides \$31,050 for operating costs incurred by the Coachella Valley Violent Crime Gang Task Force. The City of La Quinta, the lead agency of the Task Force, will cover the operating expenses and in turn bill the County for reimbursement up to \$31,050 from the JAIBG allocation.
