**SUBJECT:** RENEWAL OF THE DECLARATION OF LOCAL EMERGENCY IN RIVERSIDE COUNTY  
DUE TO WINDSTORMS

**RECOMMENDED MOTION:** That the declaration relating to a Local Emergency in Riverside County due to windstorms and adoption of Resolution 2003-32 be renewed.

**BACKGROUND:** Whereas conditions of extreme peril to the safety of persons and property have arisen within this County due to extremely high winds from January 5 - January 8, 2003 and they still exist. Government Code Section 8630 requires the Board to review the need for continuation of the local emergency every 14 days.

It was requested that a local emergency be declared throughout the County of Riverside, California. The declaration will provide the catalyst for receiving State and/or Federal disaster assistance.
