SUBJECT: Addition of Emergency Services within County Service Area 152

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors:

- 1) Adopt Resolution No. 2003-114, Notice of Intent to Add Extended Emergency Services Within CSA 152, setting a public hearing for April 15, 2003, to determine whether the extended service of sheriff and paramedic should be added to CSA 152; and
- 2) Direct the Clerk of the Board to publish a notice of the public hearing for April 15, 2003, at 10:00am.

BACKGROUND:

County Service Area (CSA) 152 was created by the County of Riverside in 1991. The residents of the unincorporated communities of Wildomar, La Cresta, Plateau and the Farm have requested the County pursue the action necessary to provide additional emergency services for their area. Pursuant to Government Code 25210.31, the Board of Supervisors may add extended types of services within an established county service area if determined to be a public convenience and necessity. The proposed action will add extended sheriff and emergency paramedic services to CSA 152.

7 WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors, in 1991, established County Service Area
8 No. 152 (CSA 152) in the unincorporated area of Riverside County for the purpose of providing extended
9 services; and

10 WHEREAS, Government Code Section 25210.31 allows for adoption of a Resolution of Intent to
11 provide additional extended services within an existing County Service Area; and

12 WHEREAS, it has been requested that additional extended sheriff and emergency paramedic
13 services be added to CSA 152; now, therefore,

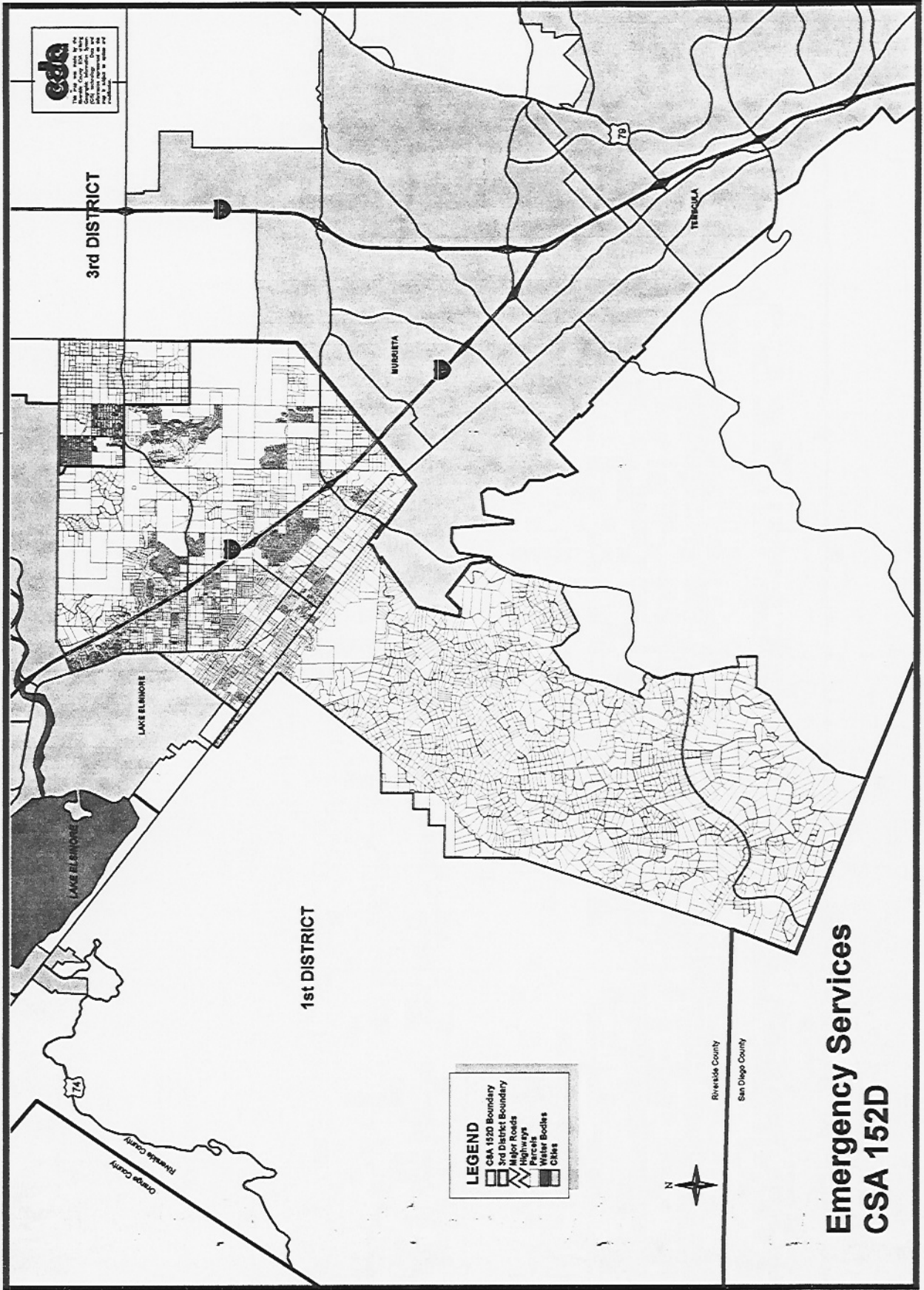
14 BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside, State of California,
15 in regular session assembled on March 11, 2003, that a public hearing will be conducted by this Board on
16 April 15, 2003, to determine whether the extended emergency services should be added to CSA 152.

17 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that such extended emergency services shall be provided to the
18 specified geographical locations as described in Exhibit "A" and that payment for such extended
19 emergency service shall be paid from service charges collected from these parcels pursuant to
20 Government Code Section 25210.77a.

21 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of this Board is to give notice of the proposed
22 hearing pursuant to Government Code Section 25210.33
