RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors:


- 1) Adopt Resolution No. 2003-116, Notice of Intent to Establish an Emergency Service Benefit Zone within County Service Area 152, setting a public hearing for April 15, 2003, to create Benefit Zone "Emergency Services 152"D"; and
- 2) Direct the Clerk of the Board to publish a notice of the public hearing for April 15, 2003, at 10:00am.

BACKGROUND:


Pursuant to Government Code 25210.8, which enables the Board of Supervisors to establish zones within any county service area with tax rates, service charges or benefit assessments varying with the extent of benefit to each zone, it is appropriate that a Benefit Zone be created to provide for emergency services for the specified geographical location as described in Exhibit "A". Therefore, it is recommended that CSA 152 "D" Benefit Zone be created.



6 WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors is considering adding the extended powers of emergency
7 services within CSA 152; and

8 WHEREAS, Government Code §25210.8 enables the Board of Supervisors to establish zones
9 within any County Service Area, with tax rates, service charges or benefit assessments varying with the
10 extent of benefit to each zone; and

11 WHEREAS, it is appropriate that a Benefit Zone be created for emergency services in the
12 unincorporated areas of Wildomar, La Cresta, Plateau and the Farm areas; now, therefore,

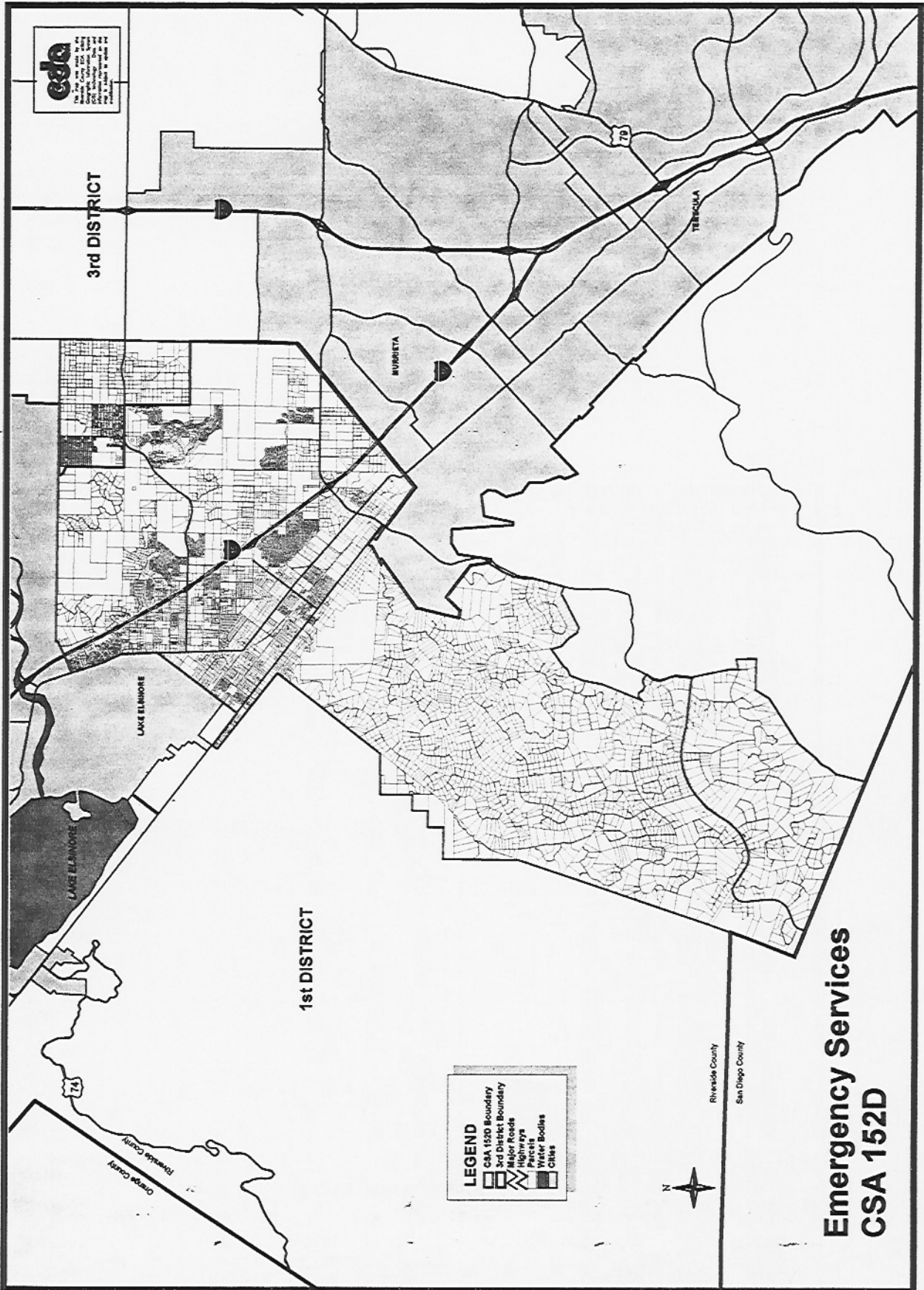

14 BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside, State of California,
15 in regular session assembled March 11, 2003, that a public hearing will be conducted by this Board on
16 April 15, 2003, to determine whether the emergency services Benefit Zone "D" should be established
17 within CSA 152, as described in Exhibit "A" attached hereto; and

18 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that such emergency services Benefit Zone "D" shall be within
19 the unincorporated area of Wildomar, La Cresta, Plateau and the Farm areas, and that payment for such
20 services shall be made from parcel assessments to be collected pursuant to Government Code
21 §25210.77(a); and

22 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of this Board is to give notice of the proposed
23 public hearing pursuant to Government Code §25210.33.
