RECOMMENDED MOTION:

That the Board of Supervisors:

1. Authorize the Department of Environmental Health to apply for and accept State grant funds designated to assist in the support of the solid waste facilities permit and inspection programs.
2. Adopt Resolution No. 2003-120

BACKGROUND:

The Riverside County Department of Environmental Health has been the designated Local Enforcement Agency (LEA) by the California Integrated Waste Management Board (CIWMB). The LEA is responsible for the permitting, inspection and enforcement of certain waste facilities within its jurisdiction. The CIWMB will disburse \$1.5 million in grant funds statewide to supplement the LEA's existing budget for equipment, supplies, training and technical support.

7 WHEREAS, the people of the State of California have authorized the issuance of grants to
8 individual and regional Local Enforcement Agencies (LEA) to carry out the Solid Waste Facilities
9 Permit and Inspection Program pursuant to Public Resources Code sections 44001 et seq.; and

11 WHEREAS, the California Integrated Waste Management Board has been delegated the
12 responsibility for administering the LEA Grant, which includes procedures governing the application by
13 and payment of grant funds to LEAs; and


15 WHEREAS, the Riverside County Department of Environmental Health is the LEA responsible
16 for permitting, inspection, and enforcement duties within its jurisdiction;

18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors authorizes the
19 Department of Environmental Health LEA to apply for, receive funding for, and administer the LEA
20 grant for the period commencing with the Fiscal Year 2003/2004 LEA Grant to and including the Fiscal
21 year 2008-2009 LEA Grant.

23 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Director of Environmental Health or his/her designee, is
24 hereby authorized and empowered to execute in the name of the Riverside County Department of
25 Environmental Health LEA all grant documents necessary to secure grant funds and implement the
26 approved grant project.
