SUBJECT: Resolution 413-526 to Establish a No-Stopping Zone,
Bellevue Avenue, Mira Loma area

RECOMMENDED MOTION:

That the Board adopt Resolution 413-526 to establish a No-Stopping Zone on Bellevue Avenue in the Mira Loma area, as described in attached Resolution 413-526.

BACKGROUND:


The Transportation Department was contacted by the staff of the Jurupa Valley High School who are concerned about the loading and unloading of students on Bellevue Avenue in front of the school staff parking lot near Martin Street. The loading activities create more conflicts with through traffic and student pedestrians crossing Bellevue Avenue.

Transportation Department staff conducted a field review of the site and determined that the proposed no-stopping zone will minimize the above-stated conflicts and improve traffic operations and safety in front of the school on Bellevue Avenue. Both the Riverside Area of the California Highway Patrol (CHP) and the school staff support the proposed No-Stopping Zone.

Based on this review, the Transportation Department recommends approval of this No-Stopping Zone.

The Transportation Department staff has contacted the Riverside Area office of the CHP regarding the proposed zone.

County Counsel has approved this resolution.

8 Zone is hereby established in the Mira Loma area:

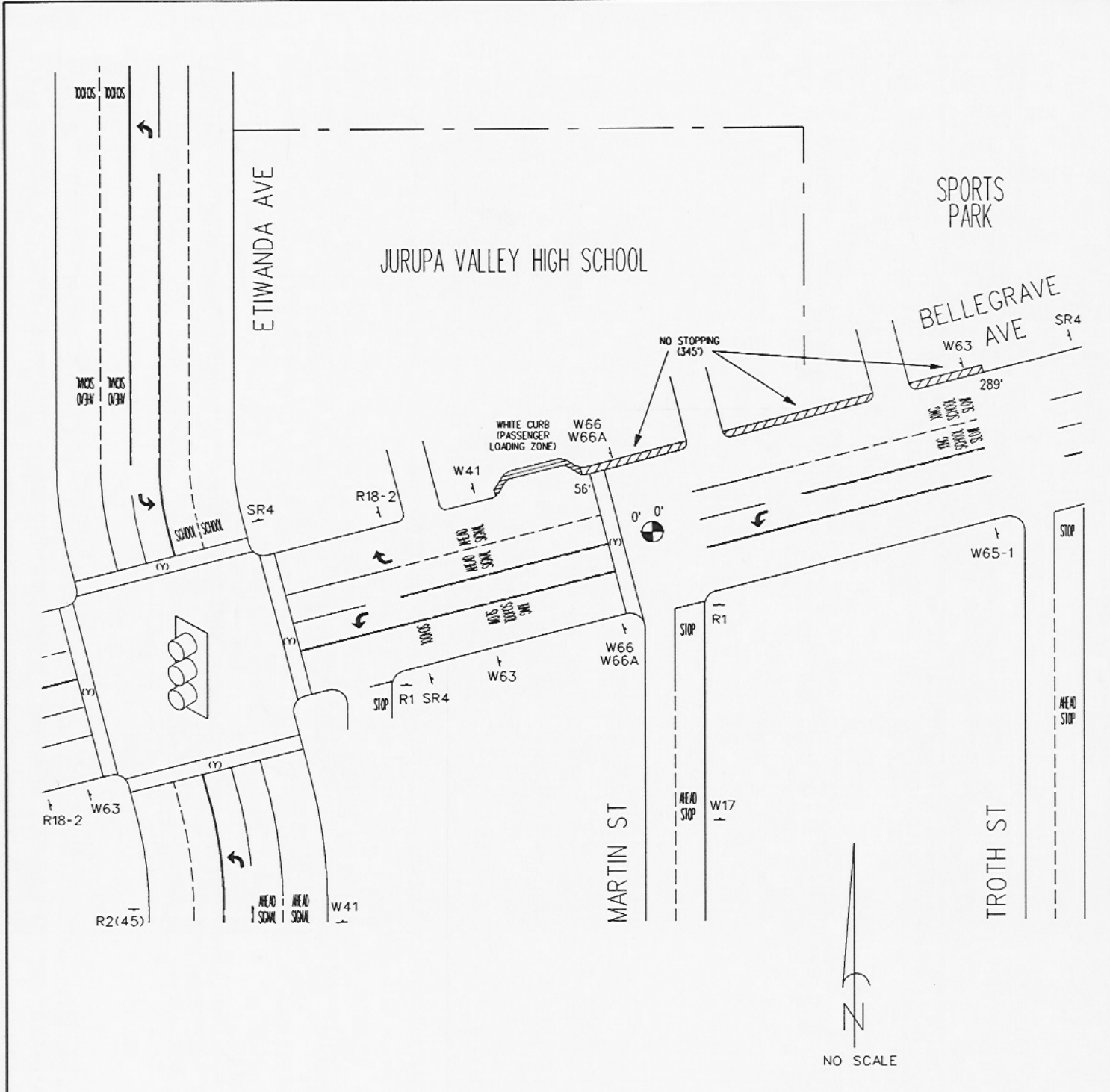

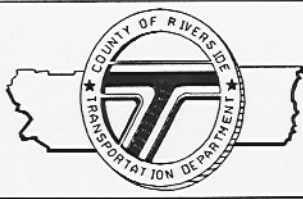
