RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board approve the attached Right of Entry Agreement between the County of Riverside and the Union Pacific Railroad Company, and authorize the Chairman of the Board to execute the Agreement.

BACKGROUND: The County of Riverside plans to modify the existing traffic signal at the intersection of Van Buren Boulevard and Jurupa Road to improve signal visibility, minimize equipment malfunctions, and construct roadway improvements to improve intersection operations and safety. To construct the roadway improvements, it is necessary to enter into Union Pacific Railroad right-of-way during construction.
