SUBJECT:

Road Maintenance Agreement between the County and the City of Riverside along Van Buren Boulevard and Wood Road in the Woodcrest Area, First Supervisorial District

RECOMMENDED MOTION:

That the Board approve the Road Maintenance Agreement between the County and the City of Riverside and authorize the Chairperson to execute the Agreement on behalf of the County of Riverside

BACKGROUND:

The City of Riverside received a request on behalf of Tosco Corporation, owner of a Circle K convenience store located at the southwesterly corner of Van Buren Boulevard and Wood Road. This request was made to connect to the city's public sewer system due to a irreparably failed septic tank. The City applied through LAFCO for the subject property to be annexed into the City. A condition of LAFCO's approval of the annexation was for the City to enter into an agreement with the County of Riverside for the City to maintain portions of Wood Road and Van Buren Boulevard. This agreement was prepared by the City, reviewed by County Counsel, and is now recommended by the Transportation Department for approval by the Board.
