

SUBJECT: Desert Resorts Regional Airport Heavy Ramp Project (Fourth District)

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board:

1. Approve the Contract Documents (Construction Drawings and Specifications) for the Desert Resorts Regional Airport Heavy Ramp project;
2. Authorize the Clerk of the Board to advertise for bids for the construction of the improvements; and
3. Delegate Change Order authority to the Assistant County Executive Officer/Economic Development Agency (Assistant CEO/EDA) in amounts that are in accordance with Board Policy.

BACKGROUND: The purpose of the project is to: 1) build a new heavy duty ramp to accommodate the larger aircraft that are utilizing the facility, 2) rehabilitate taxiway A, and 3) construct a small taxiway to accommodate construction of additional general aviation aircraft at Desert Resorts Regional Airport. The project will be funded with Federal Aviation Administration grants, with matching funds from an on-airport business, Aviation Division funds, and (potentially) Caltrans Division of Aeronautics grant funds. Staff recommends approval of the recommended motions. No County funds will be expended this fiscal year (02/03) and the FAA and County Counsel have approved the Contract Documents.
