SUBJECT: Fifth Supervisorial District Community Clean Up-Romoland and Homeland

RECOMMENDED MOTION: Authorize the Waste Management Department to waive the fees for the disposal of the community clean up waste at the County Lamb Canyon Landfill on Wednesday, April 9; Friday, April 11; Saturday, April 12; and Monday, April 14, 2003.

BACKGROUND: The residents within the unincorporated area of Romoland and Homeland have requested an annual clean up of yard waste with free disposal of those wastes at the County Landfill. Upon presentation of a valid California Driver's License showing a zip code within the Romoland/Homeland area, residents will be able to have their tipping fees waived at the Lamb Canyon Landfill site on Saturday, April 12, 2003. Tipping fees will be waived on April 9, 11, and 14, 2003 for the waste hauler, Waste Management, Inc.

Waste generated by building contractors, roofers, gardeners, and other business/commercial establishments are not included in the proposed disposal fee waiver.
