BACKGROUND: On January 14, 2003 the Board of Supervisors approved the contract between the County and MSRC for grant funds to help offset the counties costs associated with the PM Trap retrofits approved by the Board last year. The program has been granted an extension of time for completion of the retrofits on the counties on-road heavy-duty diesel vehicles, to August of this year. The retrofits are proceeding at a satisfactory pace and will be complete prior to the end of the extension period.
