SUBJECT: Ordinance 630.9 amending the fee for rescue licensing.

RECOMMENDED MOTION: Adopt County Ordinance 630.9, Regulating The Keeping and Control of Dogs, Cats, and Other Animals, and Providing For the Control and Suppression of Rabies, as revised by the Board, pursuant to Board direction by Agenda item 3.8 on January 7, 2003.

BACKGROUND: On January 7, 2003, the Board of Supervisors accepted the recommendations of the Blue Ribbon Committee to correct Ordinance 630.8, Regulating the Keeping and Control of Dogs, Cats and other Animals, and Providing For the Control and Suppression of Rabies. During discussion of Agenda item 3.8, the Board directed a minor correction to Ordinance 630.8 pursuant to the recommendation of the Department of Animal Services regarding fees for rescue licensing. This Ordinance 630.9 would increase that fee accordingly.
