**BACKGROUND:**

DPSS is making available one-time funds to the Torres-Martinez Desert Cahuilla Indian Tribe, the only other governmental TANF (Temporary Assistance to Needy Families) administrator in Riverside County, to help them equip their child care center which is currently under construction on their reservation. The funds are TANF Performance Incentive Funds to support programs and services that serve CalWORKs clients. CalWORKs is California's enactment of the federal TANF program.

The Torres-Martinez Desert Cahuilla Indian Tribe submitted a proposal requesting \$208,685 in funding to cover the cost of equipment, appliances, furniture, and classroom material for the child care center.

If the Board approves the attached Agreement, DPSS will advance to the Tribe \$208,685 in TANF Performance Incentive funds, made available to DPSS by the California Department of Social Services.

**FINANCIAL DATA:**

No County General Funds will be used. However, any TANF Performance Incentive funds not expended by June 30, 2003 may not be available to the County next year.
