SUBJECT: Authorizing the Additional Service of Emergency Services
within County Service Area 152, Public Hearing

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors:

- 1) Conduct the public hearing for the project; and
- 2) Upon the close of the Public Hearing, adopt Resolution No.2003-115, Authorizing the Addition of Emergency Services.

BACKGROUND: County Service Area (CSA) 152 was created by the County of Riverside in 1991. The residents of the unincorporated communities of Wildomar, La Cresta, Plateau and Farm have requested the County pursue the action necessary to provide additional emergency services for these areas. Pursuant to Government Code 25210.31, the Board of Supervisors may add extended types of services within an established county service area if determined to be a public convenience and necessity. The adoption of Resolution No. 2003-115 will authorize CSA 152 to provide additional emergency services.

4 AUTHORIZING THE ADDITION OF
5 EMERGENCY SERVICES WITHIN
6 COUNTY SERVICE AREA NO. 152

7 WHEREAS, Government Code Section 25210.4(a) and 25210.31(a) authorizes the County to
8 provide the extended governmental service of emergency services within an established County Service
9 Area; and

10 WHEREAS, it has been requested that emergency services be added to County Service Area No.
11 152(CSA 152); and

12 WHEREAS, a public hearing was conducted by this Board on April 15, 2003, after which this
13 Board determined that public convenience and necessity require that emergency services should be added
14 to CSA 152, in Riverside County; now, therefore,

16 BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside, State of California,
17 in regular session assembled on April 15, 2003, that emergency services shall be added to CSA 152 in the
18 County of Riverside.

20 BEIT FURTHER RESOLVED that such emergency services shall be provided locally within the
21 geographical boundaries of CSA 152, and that payment for said extended service shall be made from an
22 assessment collected pursuant to Section 25210.77(a) of the Government Code.
