SUBJECT: CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT NO. 03362 - EA 38561 - Joe Leach - Second Supervisorial District - Glen Avon Zoning District - 2.38 Acres - A-1 (Light Agriculture) and C-1/C-P (General Commercial) - Located on the south side of Mission Boulevard, north of Union Avenue, east of Conning Street and west of His Way - **REQUEST:** To legalize and expand an existing auto sales lot, with a life span of 20 years. The existing use consists of a 1,500 sq. ft. modular office, a 4,652 sq. ft. paved outdoor sales area, with approx. 70,400 sq. ft. of auto storage area for up to 173 vehicles. All repairs will be done off-site.

CONTROVERSIAL ISSUES: Allowances, setbacks, buffering, landscaping, and noise.
