**SUBJECT:** 2003 Labor Market Study

**RECOMMENDED MOTION:** That the Riverside County Board of Supervisors approve and authorize the Chairman to execute Standard Agreement No. M382069 between the State of California Employment Development Department (EDD) and the County of Riverside.

**BACKGROUND:** Riverside County was awarded \$174,084 by EDD to conduct an annual labor market study of 50 occupations for Program Years 2003, 2004 and 2005 under the California Cooperative Occupational Information System (CCOIS). The Riverside County Economic Development Agency (EDA) will work with the EDD Labor Market Information Division in the collection, analysis and dissemination of local occupational outlook and training resource information. The information is used primarily by local employment and training agencies in program planning, program marketing, career counseling, job placement, curriculum design and economic development. The results derived from this study will also be utilized to provide information to enhance Workforce Investment Act (WIA) Outplacement activities throughout Riverside County.

EDA, for the first time, is working concurrently with San Bernardino County on this project to compile the information and produce a joint Occupational Outlook Report to present labor market information for the entire Inland Empire region.
