RECOMMENDED MOTION:

2. Authorizes the County Purchasing Department to execute any future amendments that do not exceed the original allocation.

BACKGROUND:

The Riverside City Council, wanting to address the need for emergency shelter for women and children in the City of Riverside, approved the allocation of \$300,000 in general funds and \$50,000 in Riverside Redevelopment Agency funds toward the construction of the Women and Children Shelter in Riverside, scheduled to open March 31, 2003. The date on the certificate of occupancy is March 18, 2003.

The term of the Agreement of May 21, 2001 through January 2, 2003 will allow the County to charge any allowable expenses incurred during this period to the \$350,000.

The Board previously approved a similar City of Riverside agreement (for Emergency Shelter Grant Funds) on March 11, 2003 (#3.23) in the amount of \$118,750 for services provided at the Men's and Women and Children Shelters, and the Emergency Cold Weather Shelter in Riverside.

FINANCIAL DATA:

No County funds are involved with this Agreement; additional funding was included in the current fiscal year's budget, therefore, sufficient funds exist.
