RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors:

- 1) Ratify the receipt of funding from the Community Health Corporation to the Riverside County Regional Medical Center (RCRMC) in the amount of \$200,000;
- 2) Direct the Auditor-Controller to:
 - Increase appropriations 40050-4300100000-4-546160 (Equipment-Other) \$200,000,
 - Increase estimated revenue 40050-4300100000-4-776300 (Other/Hospital Revenue) \$200,000;
- 3) Direct the Clerk of the Board to send one minute order of this action to RCRMC Contracts Administration.

BACKGROUND: RCRMC has been awarded a grant by the Community Health Corporation for purchase of pediatric neurosurgery equipment. Children who require neurosurgical intervention at RCRMC will benefit from this grant.
