**SUBJECT:** Approval of Agreement with the U. S. Department of Agriculture

**RECOMMENDED MOTION:** Move that the Board of Supervisors approve the Agreement with the U. S. Department of Agriculture for the provision of law enforcement escorts during inspections for suspected outbreaks of Exotic Newcastle Disease and authorize the Chairman to sign all copies of the Agreement.

**BACKGROUND:** The U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) has requested that the Sheriff's Department provide Deputy Sheriffs as escorts during its agents' inspections for outbreaks of Exotic Newcastle Disease at farms and other areas in Riverside County.

This proposed three-year supplemental law enforcement services Agreement provides for the reimbursement of the Sheriff's Department at Board approved Extra Duty rates. County Counsel has approved the Agreement as to form.

Note that the current year's cost estimate is not included here. The frequency of these inspections is such that the Sheriff's Department can handle them within the parameters of normal daily patrol. However, this Agreement gives us the option to charge the USDA should the frequency become unmanageable.
