SUBJECT: One Time Only (OTO) Contract with Joslyn Cove Senior Center to develop a Public Education Program on aging issues.

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That your Honorable Board:

1. Ratify the agreement with Joslyn Cove Senior Center and authorize Chairman of the Board to sign the agreement.
2. Direct the Clerk of the Board to retain one (1) original copy and return two (2) original copies to the Office on Aging for further processing.

BACKGROUND: Under our agreement with California Department on Aging (CDA) One Time Only (OTO) funds can be used for the following purposes:

- Purchase of equipment which enhances the delivery of services to the eligible population
- Home and Community based projects, as approved by CDA
- Innovative pilot projects, as approved by CDA

This One Time Only (OTO) agreement with Joslyn Cove Senior Center, in the reimbursable amount of \$15,000, allows for an innovated Public Education Program. The program will be promoted to the general public as well as the gay and lesbian population in order to increase awareness of aging issues.
