SUBJECT: One Time Only (OTO) Contract with Visiting Nurses Association of the Inland Counties for Personal Care/Home Health Aids program covering Riverside County.

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That your Honorable Board:

1. Ratify the agreement with Visiting Nurses Association of the Inland Counties and authorize Chairman of the Board to sign the agreement.
2. Direct the Clerk of the Board to retain one (1) original copy and return two (2) original copies to the Office on Aging for further processing.

BACKGROUND: Under our agreement with California Department on Aging, One Time Only (OTO) funds can be used for the following purposes:

- Purchase of equipment which enhances the delivery of services to the eligible population
- Home and Community based projects, as approved by CDA
- Innovative pilot projects, as approved by CDA

This OTO agreement with Visiting Nurses Association of the Inland Counties, in the reimbursable amount of \$69,407, allows for an innovated Personal Care/Home Health Aids program. Using existing technology and equipment Visiting Nurses Association of the Inland Counties can monitor clients' physical and mental health on a scheduled and predetermined time frame.

The target population of elderly are recent released patients with limiting disability that either live alone or in a rural setting. Monitoring by Telecare Machines enables qualified personal to visit 3 – 4 clients daily.
