SUBJECT: Ratify "Modification No. 3" to Agreement DPH01K.056, entitled "Early Access to Defibrillation for Victims of Out of Hospital Cardiac Arrest", between the Community Health Agency / Emergency Medical Services (EMS) Agency and the University of Washington.

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors: 1) Ratify "Modification No. 3" to the Agreement between the Community Health Agency / Emergency Medical Services and the University of Washington to extend the performance ending date to December 31, 2003 in the amount of \$69,912; 2) Authorize the Chairperson to execute four (4) copies of said Amendment; and 3) Direct the Clerk of the Board to retain one copy and return three (3) executed copies of the documents to the Community Health Agency Contracts Administrator for final processing.

BACKGROUND: On September 12, 2000, the Board of Supervisors approved the Agreement with the University of Washington for the project entitled "Early Access to Defibrillation for Victims of out of Hospital Cardiac Arrest."

Background (continued):

The approval of this Agreement allowed the Community Health Agency / EMS Agency to implement a countywide program in which eight hundred sixty-three (863) volunteers from thirty-eight (38) locations have been trained to respond on medical emergencies and provide either CPR only or CPR with the use of an automatic external defibrillator (AED). For purposes of this study, volunteers at half of the locations have been trained to use CPR only while volunteers at the other half of the locations have been trained to use an AED with CPR.

The EMS Agency and other stakeholders of the PAD Trial Study have determined the study needs to be extended until December 31, 2003. This Amendment also provides for changes in the payment structure from being based on data acquisitions to fixed quarterly payments of \$647.34 per study unit starting February 1, 2003. Thirty-six (36) study units have agreed to remain in the study for the extension. This equates to fixed deliverable quarterly payments of \$23,304, which will be \$38,840 for the remaining five (5) months of the 2002/2003 fiscal year and \$31,072 for the 2003/2004 fiscal year. The total fixed payments will be \$69,912 for the remainder of the trial study.

"Modification No. 1" (executed on April 24, 2001) and "Modification No. 2" (executed on November 20, 2001) amended Exhibit B by increasing the overall price of Agreement DPH01K.056. In addition, these modifications amended Exhibit C (Special Conditions) of Agreement DPH01K.056 by adding the National Institutes of Health's (NIH) training requirement and salary limitation requirement.

"Modification No. 3" adds the following to the Agreement:

1. Extends the performance period of Agreement DPH01K.056 entitled "Early Access to Defibrillation for Victims of Out of Hospital Cardiac Arrest" until December 31, 2003.
2. Amends Exhibit B, Budget to be based on fixed deliverables of \$215.78 per active study unit per month from February 1, 2003 through September 30, 2003. From October 1, 2003 through November 30, 2003, during data completion and data clean up, fixed deliverables will be based on \$107.98 per unit per month.
3. Increases the Limitation of Funds payment by \$145,000 from \$230,000 to \$375,000.
