
SUBJECT: Special Maintenance Projects for Fiscal Year 2003/2004

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board authorize the Transportation Department to begin work in May 2003 on the 2003/2004 fiscal year Special Maintenance Projects.

BACKGROUND: The activities to be performed for the Special Maintenance Projects include applying a seal coat to the pavement. A seal coat is an application of asphaltic emulsion which may be immediately covered by a layer of rock chips (chip seal) or a sand/emulsion mixture (slurry seal). These applications can not be made when the pavement temperature is below 80 degrees Fahrenheit. The months of May through September provide the most optimum weather conditions for this maintenance. This program is consistent with the Board policy established at the workshop in June 1996. Slurry seal is being used on local residential streets with curb and gutter whenever possible to minimize complaints of loose rock chips.

The Special Maintenance Projects identified in the attached document will be included in the 2003/2004 annual edition of the Transportation Improvement Program. Work should begin on these projects now to ensure they will be complete by fall 2003.


