



BACKGROUND (CONT'D)

This committee works to encourage and educate the public to understand the nature of drug problems and encourage support of residents throughout the County for the development and implementation of effective substance abuse programs. The committee provides assistance to substance abuse and mental health department staff by working on the planning, review, and oversight of County-operated and contract programs.

The committee has between nine (9) and twenty (20) members that are appointed by the Board of Supervisors. Each member serves a three (3) year term and includes representatives from social services, education, law enforcement, health, and the judiciary, as well as community members.

The Department of Mental Health's Substance Abuse Program would like to honor Jan Matteson, Reba Stiles and Dr. Joseph Galleta with a proclamation from the Board in recognition of his/her tireless years of service and dedication as a member on the Riverside County Advisory Committee on Substance Abuse Programs.
