- 2) Direct the Executive Office to transfer \$130,000 from the Third District Public Facilities Developer Agreement Fund No. 30558-1103500000 to Mitigation Operations Fund No. 22550;
- 3) Direct the Executive Office to transfer \$130,000 from Mitigation Operations Fund No. 22550-1103500000 to the Transportation Department's Special Revenue Fund for Capital Projects No. 20000-3130500000;

BACKGROUND:

The Hamilton Museum is located south of State Route 371 in Anza. It takes its access from Contreras Road, which is paved and County-maintained from State Route 371 south to Johnson Road. South of Johnson Road, Contreras Road is a privately maintained dirt road.

I have an interest in paving this section of Contreras, from Johnson Road south to the Museum, to improve access and provide a paved and striped parking area. The work will be done by the Transportation Department's Day Labor Crew, with permission from the property owner. The new paving will not be brought into the County-maintained system.
