FREEWAY IMPROVEMENT PURPOSES/CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF
TRANSPORTATION - INTERSTATE 215/91/60 SEQUENCING PROJECT

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors consider approving Resolution 2003-150, Notice of Intention to Condemn Real Property for freeway improvement purposes on behalf of the State of California Department of Transportation for the Interstate 215/91/60 sequencing project, and to set a public hearing for Resolution 2003-159, Authorizing Condemnation of Real Property for Freeway Improvement Purposes, on June 24, 2003.

BACKGROUND: Pursuant to Minute Order 3.33 approved by the Board of Supervisors on November 26, 2002, a resolution was passed agreeing to hear Resolutions Authorizing Condemnation on behalf of the State of California Department of Transportation. As a prelude thereto, it is necessary for the Board to consider adopting Resolutions of Notice of Intent to Condemn Real Property for parcels affected by the project.

4 NOTICE OF INTENTION TO CONDEMN REAL PROPERTY
5 FOR FREEWAY IMPROVEMENT PURPOSES

6 BE IT RESOLVED, FOUND, DETERMINED, AND ORDERED by the Board of
7 Supervisors of Riverside County, State of California, in regular session assembled on
8 May 20, 2003, and NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN as follows:

9 1. That this Board consider passing a resolution of necessity
10 authorizing the condemnation of certain parcels of real property for freeway
11 improvement purposes described as Assessor's Parcel Number 209-223-001, also
12 known as Caltrans Parcel #17725, shown as legal descriptions and plat maps on file in
13 the Office of the Clerk of the Board, and located in Riverside, and to hold a public
14 hearing on June 24, 2003, at 10:00 a.m. in the meeting room of the Board of
15 Supervisors located on the 1st Floor, County Administrative Center Annex, 4080 Lemon
16 Street, Riverside, California, at which time the person or entity whose real property is
17 sought to be condemned and whose name and address appears on the last equalized
18 County Assessment Roll and who has filed a timely written request to appear and be
19 heard, will be given an opportunity to be heard on the following matters:

20 a. Whether the public interest and necessity require the
21 construction of the public improvement.

22 b. Whether the public improvement is planned and located in
23 the manner that will be most compatible with the greatest public good and the least
24 private injury.

25 c. Whether the real property sought to be acquired is
26 necessary for the construction of the public improvement.

27 2. That the failure of any person, whose real property is sought to be
28 condemned, to file a written request to appear and be heard with the Clerk of the Board
within 15 days after a copy of the resolution is mailed to, or personally served upon
such person, will result in his or her waiver of the right to appear and be heard.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the State of California, Department of
Transportation, has caused a letter of intent, see attached, and a copy of the right of
way map to be mailed to or personally served upon each person or entity whose real
property is sought to be condemned and whose name and address appears on the last
equalized County Assessment Roll.
