Cooperative Agreement

**RECOMMENDED MOTION:**

- Approve the Cooperative Agreement between the District, the City of Palm Springs (City) and the Agua Caliente Band of Cahuilla Indians (Tribe); and authorize the Chairman to execute the Agreement documents on behalf of the District.

**JUSTIFICATION:**

The Agreement sets forth the terms and conditions by which certain storm drain facilities required as a condition of City's approval of Tribe's proposed casino expansion are to be constructed by the Tribe, inspected by the District and City and operated and maintained by the District and City. Upon completion of the project, the District will assume responsibility for operation and maintenance of the basin and mainline storm drain and the City will assume responsibility for operation and maintenance of the associated catch basins and connector pipes.

County Counsel has approved the Agreement documents as to legal form. The City and Tribe have executed the Agreement.

**FINANCIAL:**

The Tribe is funding all construction and construction inspection costs. The District will incur future operation and maintenance costs.
