

SUBJECT: Ratify the Intergovernmental Agreement between the Riverside County Department of Public Health and the County of San Bernardino Department of Public Health for the governance of the Regional Immunization Registry.

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors: 1) Ratify the Intergovernmental Agreement between the Riverside County Department of Public Health and the County of San Bernardino Department of Public Health for the governance of the Regional Immunization Registry; 2) Authorize the Chairman of the Board to sign seven (7) original copies of the Agreement; 3) Direct the Clerk of the Board to return all seven (7) copies of the Agreement to the Community Health Agency Contracts Administrator for further processing.

BACKGROUND: The California Department of Health Services has awarded local health departments local assistance funds for regional immunization registries. Riverside County has joined with the existing San Bernardino Department of Public Health immunization registry to form the Inland Empire Immunization Tracking System (IEITS). On December 19, 2000, item 3.31,

SUBJECT: Ratify the Intergovernmental Agreement between the Riverside County Department of Public Health and the County of San Bernardino Department of Public Health for the governance of the Regional Immunization Registry.

BACKGROUND continued: the Board approved the concept of a shared Immunization Tracking Registry. The IEITS is an interagency project with the goal of improving the health of the community by assuring that all children receive appropriate preventive services, particularly immunizations. The IEITS intends to link all providers including public and private providers, managed care, hospital-based health delivery systems and other agencies, such as schools, foster care, and WIC, within each of the participating counties to a central database for the coordinated registry of immunization information on children.

One of the requirements of the state contract was to develop and execute regional governance procedures and inter-county agreements. The purpose of the Governance Agreement is to document the understanding between both counties for the planning, management, funding and operation of the IEITS.

The Agreement was previously approved by the Board on February 26, 2002, Item 3.18, and was approved by the Board of Supervisors of San Bernardino County on January 7, 2003 as Contract #03-0004. Article 11, concerning the term of the agreement, has been amended to read that the agreement will remain in effect until terminated or a new agreement is signed. All other articles remain the same in effect.

This amendment has been approved as to form by County Counsel.
