BACKGROUND: Adoption of Resolution No. 2003-246 appoints the Director of the Transportation Department as the Engineer to prepare a Report regarding the proposed annexation of Zone 15 into Landscaping and Lighting Maintenance District No. 89-1-Consolidated (L&LM Dist. No. 89-1-C).

Resolution No. 2003-247 declares the Board's intention of ordering the annexation of Zone 15 into L&LM Dist. No. 89-1-C. Annexation of Zone 15 into L&LM Dist. No. 89-1-C will fund the maintenance and servicing of landscaping and catch basin filtration system improvements within public right-of-ways located northeasterly of Lyon Ave. between Victoria Ave. and Mon Blanc Dr.; southwesterly of Victoria Ave. easterly of Lyon Ave.; northwesterly and southeasterly sides of Dufferin Ave. between Lyon Ave. and Traditions Ct.; northwesterly of Dufferin Ave. between Traditions Ct. and La Sierra Ave.; southwesterly of La Sierra Ave. northerly of Dufferin Ave. in the La Sierra area and includes 61 single-family residential lots.

The proposed budget of Fiscal Year 2003-2004 for Zone 15 is \$19,720.00 that will result in an assessment for Fiscal Year 2003-2004 within Zone 15 of \$315.90 per parcel. The annual assessment will be adjusted annually by the greater of 2% or the cumulative percentage increase in the CPI-U, if any, as it stands as of March of each year over the base index for March of 2003.

Consistent with the Board's direction regarding compliance with Article XIID of the California Constitution and the Landscaping and Lighting Act of 1972, the attached resolutions have been prepared and a public hearing scheduled for 10:00 a.m. on July 29, 2003, to receive testimony for and against the proposed assessment. Each property owner within the proposed Zone 15 will receive a notice of the public hearing and mail-in ballot, an impartial analysis, a copy of Resolution No. 2003-247 and an information sheet.

All ballots must be returned prior to the conclusion of the public hearing. If, at the time designated for the tabulation of the ballots, the ballots submitted in favor of the annexation and levy of the assessment exceed the ballots submitted in opposition of the annexation and levy of the assessment of Zone 15, Zone 15 will be annexed into L&LM Dist No. 89-1-C.
