**SUBJECT:** Cooperative Funding Agreement with Riverside County Transportation Commission, Route 79 & Gilman Springs Road Interchange Improvements, San Jacinto Area

**RECOMMENDED MOTION:** That the Board of Supervisors approve the cooperative funding agreement between the County of Riverside and Riverside County Transportation Commission to improve the Route 79 & Gilman Springs Road Interchange, and authorize the Chairman of the Board to execute the document on behalf of the County.

**BACKGROUND:** It is the intent of the County and the Riverside County Transportation Commission (RCTC) that the subject interchange improvements be constructed under the same contract as the County's Gilman Springs Phase II construction improvements. The interchange improvements will improve the operation and safety of the interchange by providing exclusive right-turn lanes from Gilman Springs Road onto the Northbound and Southbound on-ramps, and providing drainage and lighting modifications. The County would be the lead agency on the combined project.

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The total project cost, excluding design, is estimated at \$290,000. The negotiated terms of the agreement are that RCTC will contribute \$100,000 plus the costs for design, and the County will fund the balance. The County's share is therefore estimated at \$190,000.
