Funds are included in the District's Zone 4 budget for this project.

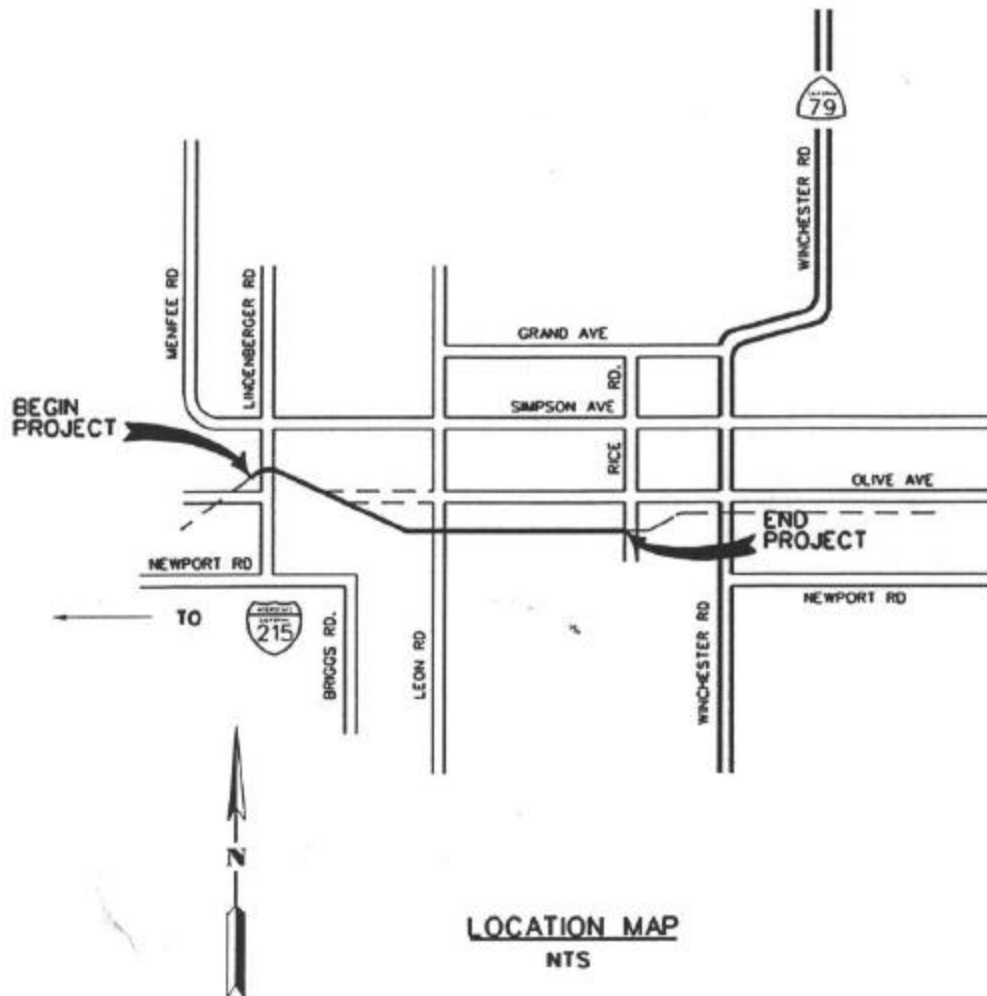

SALT CREEK CHANNEL STAGE 6 PROJECT NO.4-0-0110



The Salt Creek Channel Stage 6 project consists of excavating 3.2 miles of earthen trapezoidal channel in the Winchester area of Riverside County. Construction will start at approximately 750' downstream of Lindenberger Road (adjacent Menifee Lakes Golf Course) and proceed easterly within District right of way to Rice Road. Included in this project is the installation of reinforced concrete pipe inlets to drain local flows. A 40 to 60 foot riparian wetland strip along the center of the channel will be protected during construction.
