SUBJECT: Renewal agreements with San Jacinto Unified School District and Hemet Unified School District for continuation of library service in San Jacinto and Anza.

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board:

- 1) Approve, and authorize the Chairman to sign, Amendment No. 1 Joint-Use Agreement between the County of Riverside and the San Jacinto Unified for the Joint-Use of Facilities located at San Jacinto High School; and
- 2) Approve, and authorize the Chairman to sign, the Joint Use Agreement Between the County of Riverside and Hemet Unified School District for the Joint Use of Facilities Located at Hamilton School.

BACKGROUND: The County Library provides public library service to the residents of San Jacinto and Anza via joint-use library facilities operated in conjunction with San Jacinto Unified School District and Hemet Unified School District. The San Jacinto Library has been in operation for three years and the Anza Library has been in operation for five years. Both libraries have been widely recognized as models of joint-use cooperative libraries. On-going County library operations in both locations are provided via the contract with LSSI for countywide library services with oversight from the County Librarian. The school districts provide on-going facility maintenance. Facility costs are increased modestly at both locations. These agreements will continue library service in San Jacinto through June 30, 2006 and in Anza through June 30, 2008.
