SUBJECT: Construction of Traffic Signal and Lighting, Clinton Street and Palmyra Avenue, Indio Area

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors approve the plans and specifications for the construction of traffic signal, lighting and associated improvements at the intersection of Clinton Street and Palmyra Avenue in the Indio area of Riverside County. Authorize the Clerk to advertise for bids to be received in the office of the Director of Transportation up to the hour of 2:00 pm, Wednesday, July 16, 2003, at which time bids will be opened.

BACKGROUND: The 2002-2003 Transportation Improvement Program provides for the construction of the subject improvements. The primary project funding is from Federal Hazard Elimination Safety Program - Safe Route To School funds for which the Transportation Department has successfully applied. The project is cooperative between the County, the City of Indio and the Desert Sands Unified School District. A cooperative agreement among the three agencies will be submitted to the Board of Supervisors for approval prior to the award of the construction contract.
